Make a map.

Where have you been?

Make a scrapbook (or list) of places that you have visited. Include photos or drawings to show where you went and some of the things that you did or saw.

Plant a little seed.

We have been looking at the story of the Little Red Hen. In the story, she finds some seeds and plants them. Plant a seed and watch it grow?

Flour Power!
